

Springfield of Dreams Charity Cup

Coach's Information Sheet



1. This being our first year for the tournament we are concerned whether the parking at Eagle City SC will be sufficient, so please car pool if at all possible. Please respect the directions of the parking attendants to avoid delays. We have a shuttle service planned if parking becomes insufficient. It will be located at the Home Depot located 1 mile south on Bechtle Avenue.
2. Trash receptacles will be available at many locations. Please encourage their use by your players and parents.
3. The Tournament provides the ball for all matches.
4. Report any problems to a field marshal, (field marshals will be wearing yellow vests). Radio operators will be available for emergency situations only.
5. All teams must be registered to play prior to the opening of the tournament Saturday morning. Player/Coach cards will be checked before each game. If a team was not registered at Friday night registration, the team must complete the registration process at the headquarters tent, a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the team's first game on Saturday. **THERE WILL BE NO STATE REGISTRAR AVAILABLE AFTER FRIDAY NIGHT.**
6. If you desire to warming-up before the match, you are encouraged to use open areas near the fields. Warm-ups on the field will only be allowed if time allows prior to scheduled game start time. We reserve the right to remove this option if weather threatens or field condition is threatened.
7. Referees will keep the player's cards until completion of the match. Cards will then be returned to the respective coaches.
8. Red Cards – will be held until the game suspension has been served. If you or one of your players receives a red card in your last game of the tournament we are required to return the card and game report to the Registrar of your State Association.
9. **NO ALCOHOL** is permitted at any of the Tournament sites – please assist us by reporting any infractions to Tournament officials.
10. Refreshments and T-shirts will be available for sale. Soccer supplies and Troy Strawberry Festival souvenirs will also be available.
11. In the event of inclement weather, a signal (3 sharp blast from an air horn) will be given to the referees to suspend play. Upon suspension of play, please remove your team to the parking lot and remain in your vehicles for safety until the all clear signal (1 long blast from an air horn) is given.
12. Rule reminders:
 - a. Substitutions are unlimited, standard USYSA.
 - b. On a caution, you may substitute one for one.
 - c. Unlimited substitutions, (both teams), on an injury.
13. National Trails Parks and Recreation has spent a lot of time preparing the fields. Please ask your goalkeepers and substitutes to refrain from "digging" in the goal boxes and at the sub line.
